EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Project is located on Highway 69 north of Nobel from approximately 1 km north of new Highway 559 interchange, northerly to approximately 1.8 km north of existing Woods Road. As part of this Project, access to Highway 69 will be restricted to interchanges. At-grade intersections (left and/or right turns) will not be permitted. These changes are required to improve safety and operations at existing sideroad locations.

This project includes one interchange at Woods Road. No roads will be permitted to intersect fully with Highway 69, except at the interchange identified above. In total, eleven (11) opened and unopened road allowances are to be closed.

Such decision will be mailed to you when available.
