ADDENDUM TO THE 2008 ROUTE PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT REPORT
FOR HIGHWAY 69 FOUR-LANING NORTH OF NOBEL TO HIGHWAY 522**

THE PROJECT

AECOM Canada Limited (AECOM) has been retained by the Ministry of Transportation (MTO) to undertake the Detail Design Study for the four-laning of Highway 69 from 5.3 km south of Highway 529 (North Junction) northerly to 2.2 km north of Highway 529 (North Junction) for a total distance of approximately 7.5 km including Magnetawan First Nation lands (see Key Plan). This project is being undertaken as part of the Ministry of Transportations' plans to four-lane Highway 69 between Parry Sound and Sudbury.

ADDENDUM TO THE 2008 ROUTE PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT REPORT

In February 2008, the Ministry of Transportation (MTO) completed the Route Planning and Environmental Assessment Report for Highway 69 Four-Laning North of Nobel to Highway 522 (RPEAR, 2008). In response to issues identified following the commencement of the Detail Design, and based on the results of additional investigations and assessment, a new preferred alignment has been identified. An Addendum to the RPEAR, 2008 will be prepared to document the changes and consultation which have taken place and will be available for a 30-day public review period. Notices will be published when the Addendum is available for review.

The scope of work includes:

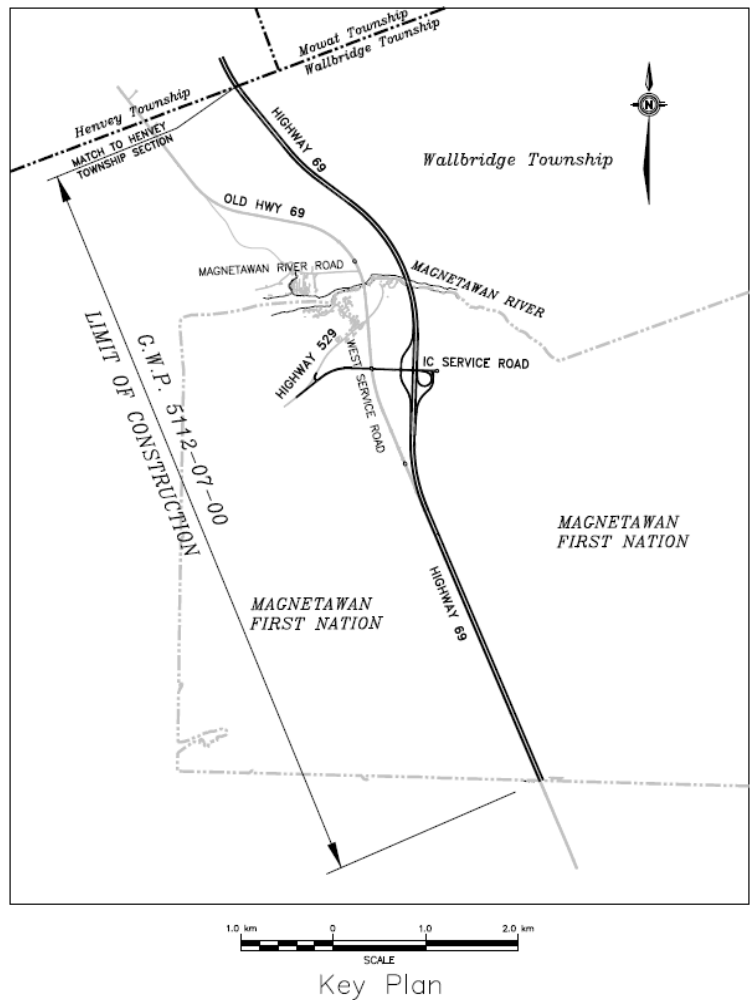
- Four-Laning of Highway 69 on twinning and new alignment sections;
- Construction of a new interchange near Highway 529, North Junction; and
- New bridge structures over the Magnetawan River.
